

RESOLUTION 08-56

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, ON THURSDAY, APRIL 9, 2009, TO ELECT A MAYOR AND ALSO ONE (1) ALDERMAN FROM EACH OF THE FOUR (4) WARDS, PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that:

The Maury County Election Commission is requested and authorized to conduct the regular municipal election for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on Thursday, April 9, 2009, for the purpose of electing a Mayor to serve a term of four (4) years ending in April 2013, and one (1) Alderman from each of the four (4) wards, all to be voted on at-large by the registered voters of the city, each Alderman to serve a term of four (4) years. The Maury County Election Commission is requested to publish notice of the election in both Maury and Williamson Counties.


The Maury County Election Commission is hereby requested and authorized to conduct early voting beginning on March 20, 2009 and ending on April 4, 2009.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to request the Maury County Election Commission to hold the aforesaid regular election on April 9, 2009, the cost of which shall be borne by the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.


