

RESOLUTION 09-114

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE TO ISSUE A LETTER OF COMMITMENT TO FUND A THIRD YEAR OF SALARIES FOR FIRE FIGHTER PERSONNEL AS PART OF A SAFER GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee is in need of additional fire fighting personnel;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee desires to apply for a SAFER (Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response) grant regarding the addition of eight firefighting positions totaling \$537,152.00 in salaries for a two year period; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee must commit to funding the third year of the salaries for eight firefighters totaling \$268,576.00 plus any additional raises given within the grant period;
and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Alderman to authorize the Mayor to issue a letter of commitment within the grant application that the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee will provide the sufficient funds necessary for compliance to the grant requirements during the third year of the grant period.


