A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF SPRING HILL, TN TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee is eligible for funds under the State of Tennessee "Small Cities" Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to rehabilitate low income, owner occupied houses in the New Town (Alex Drive/Duplex Road) section of Spring Hill, Tennessee.


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill wishes to make an application for said project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT


- (1) The Mayor be authorized and directed to execute and submit an application for funds to the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development in the amount of \$ 500,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, welfare demanding it.


