**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE
SUPPORTING THE REQUEST TO MADE TO TDOT TO FOUR LANE THE 7.3 MILE
SECTION OF HIGHWAY 412 BETWEEN HIGHWAY 31 AND EXIT 46 OF
INTERSTATE 65 AND UPGRADE THE CLOVERLEAF AT EXIT 46
SUPPORTING THE IMPROVEMENT AND WIDENING OF HIGHWAY 412**

WHEREAS, State Route 43 is a regional four lane system for the State of Tennessee serving the south central Tennessee region; and

WHEREAS, State Route 43 is an existing four-lane system from the State of Alabama to the intersection of Highway 31 in Columbia, Maury County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Highway 412 provides the continuous flow and most direct access from the intersection at State Routes 43 and 31 to Interstate 65 at Exit 46; and

WHEREAS, the four-lane traffic pattern provided by State Route 43 merges into the two-lane Highway 412 at its most high traffic critical point as traffic seeks a continuous flow pattern linking directly to Interstate 65; and

WHEREAS, Both the Maury County Commission and the Columbia City Council have passed resolutions in support of these two projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is located partially within Maury County and is supportive of roadway infrastructure projects within Maury County.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill that the Tennessee Department of Transportation:

- Complete the engineering design work to four-lane 7.3 miles of Highway 412 from the intersection of State Route 43 and 31 to Interstate 65 and to classify the project as Shovel Ready
- Complete the re-design engineering work for a new or upgraded cloverleaf Interchange at Exit 46 off Interstate 65 and to classify the project as Shovel Ready
- The State of Tennessee provide the funding for completing the two identified Shovel Ready projects by the year 2014

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Governor Phil Bredesen, Senator Bill Ketron,


Representative Ty Cobb, and Department of Transportation Commissioner Gerald Nicely be provided with a copy of this Resolution.


