Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 16th day of August, 2010.







Said apparatus is to be built and shipped in accordance with the specifications hereto attached, delays due to strikes, war or international conflict, failures to obtain chassis, materials, or other causes beyond our control not preventing, within 180 - 210 calendar days or less after receipt of this order and the acceptance thereof at our Appleton, Wisconsin office, and to be delivered to you at the Spring Hill TN Fire Department.

The specifications herein contained shall form a part of the final contract, and are subject to changes desired by the purchaser, provided such alterations are interlined prior to the acceptance by the company of the order to purchase, and provide such alterations do not materially affect the cost of the construction of the apparatus.

The proposal for fire apparatus conforms to all Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) rules and regulations in effect at the time of the bid and with all National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Guidelines for Automotive Fire Apparatus as published at the time of bid, except as modified by customer specifications. Any increased costs incurred by first party because of future changes in or additions to said DOT or NFPA standards will be passed along to the customers as an addition to the price set forth above.
