

RESOLUTION 11-126

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PAVING AT HAMPTON SPRINGS
SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, to better serve the citizens of Spring Hill, the City accepted proposals for various road improvements on October 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill previously activated the Performance Bond conditions to secure the funding for roadways in Hampton Springs Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill desires to pave 9,230 square yard of roads in Hampton Springs Subdivision and repair necessary curbing;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill awards the above referenced paving project to Tennessee Valley Paving as stated below:


\$60,271.90 (9,230 square yards at \$6.53 per square yard)
5,700.00 (Digouts)
3,000.00 (Curb Repair)
9,750.00 (to be reimbursed to the City from TVA)
\$78,721.90 (Total Expense)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding for this paving project to be drawn from proceeds from the Hampton Springs Bond.


