A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUPPORT OF TRASHERCISE TREASURE HUNT

WHEREAS, "Trasercise Treasure Hunt" will be conducted on Saturday, April 9, 2011.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 21st day of March, 2011.




