

RESOLUTION 11-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE ESTABLISHING A DESIGN REVIEW COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has an interest in maintaining the unique character of the community and in preserving and promoting high-quality aesthetic design standards; and,

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-54-133, authorizes municipalities to establish a Design Review Commission for such purpose.

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission has recommended to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that a Design Review Commission be created; and


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that there is hereby established a Design Review Commission for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the members of the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission shall serve as the Design Review Commission; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-54-133, any property owner affected by the guidelines established the Design Review Commission may appeal a decision of the Design Review Commission to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall take effect from and immediately after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.


