A Resolution to Commend Mr. Evan Hampton

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill would like to recognize the heroic and life saving measures taken by Evan Hampton on 25 July 2011.

WHEREAS, Mr. Evan Hampton is the swimming pool manager for the Longview Recreational Center in Spring Hill Tennessee.


WHEREAS, at approximately 5:30 p.m. on Monday, July 25, lifeguards spotted a 3 year old girl floating on her back in the shallow end of the outdoor pool, next to a children's play feature. When scanning back across the pool, lifeguards saw her face down in the water. Immediately a lifeguard working underneath the authority of Mr. Hampton acted swiftly in pulling the unconscious young girl from the water and began immediately performing CPR.

WHEREAS, upon arrival to the scene Mr. Hampton took over the CPR and he performed over 20 chest compressions until clearing the airway and achieving a faint pulse. Mr Hampton then performed mouth to mouth resuscitation for nearly one minute until the young girl started to breath and regained consciousness.

WHEREAS, in the performance of his duties as Pool Manager Mr. Hampton rendered medical care of a distinguished and unheralded nature to a person whose life was in immediate jeopardy, and did so in a manner that most certainly sustained the young girl and enabled the individual to be delivered alive to Maury Regional Hospital only to be released some time later and who is expected to make a full recovery.




