and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill approved funding of Multi-Terrain Loader in the 2011-2012 Capital Improvement Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill advertised and accepted proposals from qualified vendors on October 4, 2011; and


**WHEREAS**, Staff has submitted a recommendation to the Budget Finance Advisory Committee; and



### MS4 Multi Terrain Loader (Skid Steer)

#### MS4 Department Recommendation

After review of all bid documentation the MS4 Department makes the following recommendations.

Recommendations are in order of suggested preference.

Pros and cons are listed with each bid recommendation below where there are any.

All of these Multi Terrain Loaders will perform the required service needed for the MS4.

- 1) Thompson Machinery – Caterpillar 275B Series 3 \$49,658.64 - test drove equipment  
75 Horse Power/ best performance/ease of operator maintenance/minimum impact tracks for less disturbance in residential yards. Preferred buy.
- 2) Diamond Equipment – Case TR270 \$50,265.00 – did not test drive this model – did test a model with tires instead of tracks  
74 Horse Power/ regular track system /less ground clearance of 8 inches 9 requested/ ground pressure 5.5 requested 5/ probably will have slightly more impact in residential yards/ most expensive
- 3) Ditchwitch – Kubota SVL75 \$46,528.00 – test drove equipment  
74.3Horse Power/ regular tracks/ ground pressure 5.8/ probably will have slightly more impact in residential yards / second to lowest bid/ good price
- 4) Nashville Tractor – New Holland C227 \$47,658.88 – did not test drive  
74Horse Power/ ground clearance 8inches/ ground pressure 5.7/ probably will have slightly more impact in residential yards/ third lowest on bid/ good price
- 5) Bobcat of Nashville – Bobcat T190 \$39,555.26 – did not test drive  
Engine 66 Horse Power/ Hydraulics 33Horse Power/ all others hydraulics around 40 or above/ have concerns about performance due to less horse power but will most likely perform all needed functions/ ground clearance 5.03/ ground pressure 8/ probably will have slightly more impact in residential yards/ lowest bid/ can't beat the price.
