

RESOLUTION 11-99

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF EQUIPMENT ON NEW POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved the purchase of new police vehicles on August 15, 2011 in Resolutions 11-79, 11-80, and 11-81; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill property advertised and subsequently accepted Request for Proposals for this equipment on September 8, 2011 and.; and

WHEREAS, City Staff received and reviewed proposals, and the Budget Finance Advisory Committee recommends the following:

Patrol Units/Administrative Unit:

Harpeth Motors Total \$31,484.68 (includes Lights, Cages, Shot Gun Mounts) plus an additional \$3,000.00 for Striping and Lettering

State Contract Total: \$11,721.52 (includes Radar, Radios)


K-9 Unit:

Harpeth Total \$7,777.13 (includes Lights, Cages, Shot Gun Mounts, no striping needed)

State Contract Total: \$1,596.19 (includes Radar, Radios)



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 19th day of September, 2011.




