

RESOLUTION 11-122

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE WHOSE PURPOSE IS TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STRATEGIC TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND RECOMMEND ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PRIORITIES FOR CIP FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a need exists to develop an advisory committee to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen to assist in the development of a strategic transportation plan and to make recommendations regarding the priority of improvements to the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that there is hereby created a Transportation Advisory Committee consisting of two (2) members of the Board of Aldermen, and one (1) member of the Planning Commission, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the members shall be appointed at large with all appointments to be made by the Mayor.


