**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALARY INCREASE FOR THE  
SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill adopted Resolution 10-74, hiring a Municipal Court Judge and setting the salary for the position; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been proven that the Spring Hill Municipal Court Judge is underpaid; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill that the salary for Spring Hill Municipal Judge be increased to the amount of \$18,000.00 per year, not subject to yearly employee increases.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this increase shall become effective Beginning February 1, 2012.


