OUTDOOR WARNING SIRENS**


WHEREAS, the safety of the citizens of Spring Hill is a high priority to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, one proposal was received and evaluated by city staff and a recommendation has been made to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee; and



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 21th day of May, 2012.







