
**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, REQUESTING A REFERENDUM OF
PROPERTY OWNERS REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY
PARCELS**

WHEREAS, as stated by TCA Section 6-51-104, a municipality, when petitioned by interested persons, or upon its own initiative, by resolution, may propose extension of its corporate limits by the annexation of territory adjoining to its existing boundaries;


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has been petitioned by owner of property, Taylor Golden to annex the following parcels in Williamson County: Map 170, Parcel 25.07 containing 33.85 acres more or less; Map 170, parcel 15.09, containing 15.03 acres more or less; Map 170, parcel 15.12, containing 0.86 acres more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill hereby request a referendum of annexation of properties in Williamson County, as referenced above, be included on the Maury County November 2012 ballot.
