**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A LETTER OF CREDIT FOR  
COBBLESTONE VILLAGE SUBDIVISION – PHASE 1; SECTION 1 & 1B**

**WHEREAS**, a Letter of Credit is required to be established for this development prior to recording of the Final Plat;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the Letter of Credit has a “shall be deemed automatically extended, without written amendment” clause so  
it will only be terminated on written notification from Bank or by request of the City of Spring Hill; and

**WHEREAS**, the Letter of Credit is guaranteeing the construction of certain improvements for 18 lots; and

**WHEREAS**, the following Public Improvements are required pursuant to the Final Plat:

*All Public Improvements including Water, Sewer, Storm Water Drainage and Basins, Streets and  
Curbs, Sidewalks, Street Lights and final topping to all streets with 1 ½ inches of hot mix asphalt;  
and*

**WHEREAS**, to date, some improvements have not been constructed and/or accepted by the City and therefore a Letter  
of Credit is required; and

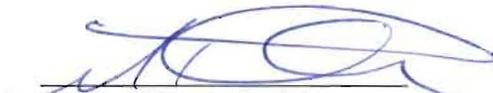
**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission that a Irrevocable Letter of  
Credit be established for twelve (12) months, in the amount of \$72,908.00; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that the date of completion for the above referenced improvements will be within the  
twelve (12) month period from the date of this resolution and in case such improvements are not completed in a timely  
manner, then the City of Spring Hill shall pursue other measures to ensure completion; and

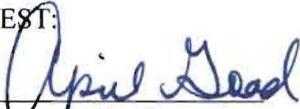
**WHEREAS**, upon completion of the public improvements listed above, the Developer will be required to file a  
“maintenance” bond guaranteeing performance of the public improvements for an additional one year period with the  
Planning Commission after the dedication and acceptance of such public improvements by the Board of Mayor and  
Aldermen.

**WHEREAS**, the Letter of Credit is guaranteeing the construction of certain improvements for 18 lots; and

**WHEREAS**, the following Public Improvements are required pursuant to the Final Plat:  
*All Public Improvements including Water, Sewer, Storm Water Drainage and Basins, Streets and Curbs, Sidewalks, Street Lights and final topping to all streets with 1 ½ inches of hot mix asphalt; and*

**WHEREAS**, to date, some improvements have not been constructed and/or accepted by the City and therefore a Letter of Credit is required; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Codes Department that a Irrevocable Letter of Credit be established for twelve (12) months, in the amount of \$72,908.00; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that the date of completion for the above referenced public improvements will be within the time prescribed for the bond and it is required that an automatic renewal clause, to the benefit of the City of Spring Hill, be included within the bond in case such improvements are not completed in a timely manner; and

**WHEREAS**, upon completion of the public improvements listed above, the Developer will be required to file a “maintenance” bond guaranteeing performance of the public improvements for an additional one year period with the Planning Commission after the dedication and acceptance of such public improvements by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Spring Hill Planning Commission that the establishment of a Letter of Credit for Cobblestone Village Subdivision Phase 1; Section 1 & 1B in the amount of \$72,908.00 is hereby recommended to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

We hereby establish an Irrevocable Letter of Credit for the account of Golden Excavating & Utilities, LLC, developer of Cobblestone Village Phase I, Section I and IB, a residential subdivision in Spring Hill, TN, in the amount of **Seventy Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and no/100 (\$72,908.00)** available by draft at sight for payment in full for completion of the water system ( with satisfactory bacteriological water sample tests), completion of the sanitary sewer system ( including vacuum testing), installation of storm water drainage system ( includes soils stabilization ), asphalt binder, asphalt topping and concrete curbing with backfill, seed & straw /matting of right- of-way. Upon completion of these items, you should notify the City and request an inspection of the infrastructure items.

In the event of the failure of the Developer to complete the water system, sewer system and installation of storm water drainage system, asphalt binder, and concrete curbing with backfill, seed & straw/matting of right-of-way, as required by the Town of Spring Hill prior to the expiration date of this instrument the Town of Spring Hill shall notify the Bank in writing. Upon such notification, the Bank shall either renew the Letter of Credit for a term acceptable to the Town of Spring Hill or pay the amount set forth above to the Town of Spring Hill. In case of default, Community First Bank & Trust hereby irrevocably agrees to pay the sum of **Seventy Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and no/100 (\$72,908.00)** for the improvements to be completed on behalf of the Town of Spring Hill in conjunction with this Project. The Town of Spring Hill agrees to refund to Community First Bank & Trust any amounts not expended by the Town of Spring Hill to complete the unfinished requirements of the said Project.

It is understood and agreed that this in no way limits the liability of the developer for any costs in addition to **Seventy Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and no/100 (\$72,908.00)**.

It is a condition of this Letter of Credit that it shall be deemed automatically extended, without amendment for a one (1) year period from the expiration date shown here on, or any future expiration date unless at least sixty (60) days prior to any expiration date we send notice to the Town of Spring Hill by Registered Mail that we elect not to renew this Letter of Credit for any such additional period.

The Bank agrees with you that your drafts under and in strict compliance with the terms of this letter of credit will be duly honored if properly presented to this Bank before the above expiration date.
