

RESOLUTION 12-106

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR WALKWAY BEGINNING AT TANYARD SPRINGS IN SPRING HILL CONNECTING AT THE TOWN LIMIT OF THOMPSON'S STATION TO A SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has demonstrated a commitment to developing multi-modal pedestrian trails and sidewalks for the movement of citizens (without the use of motorized vehicles) in the City of Spring Hill as a critical component of a complete intermodal transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill and the Town of Thompson's Station are cooperating and working through strategic planning to develop a greenways trail system to link educational institutions, historically significant sites and community centers, while provide citizens the ability to move freely across their respective municipality borders without having to get into their vehicles; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has been awarded a Transportation Enhancement grant in 2011 (PIN 114960.00) to construct a walkway beginning at Tanyard Springs in Spring Hill, with a planned terminus connecting at the Town limit of Thompson's Station to a Safe Routes to School sidewalk (PIN 110681.00) currently under construction; and

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the sidewalk project in Thompson's Station is necessary in order for both projects to connect and without a connection an eligible terminus for each project would not exist.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby affirms its support for the Transportation Enhancement walkway project beginning at Tanyard Springs in Spring Hill connecting to the Town Limit of Thompson's Station to a Safe Routes to School sidewalk; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen pledges its full support and intent to work in cooperation with the Town of Thompson's Station to complete a connection between the two projects should a connection not be completed within the confines of each respective project.


