**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL
DECLARING MAY "RELAY FOR LIFE" MONTH IN SPRING
HILL, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, Cancer will touch one in two men and one in three women during their life time.

WHEREAS, this year alone, 565,000 Americans are expected to die of cancer –more than 1,500 each day.

WHEREAS, nationwide, more than 1.4 million people will be diagnosed with cancer this year and an estimated 28,000 of those cases will be Tennessee residents.

WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society is the nationwide, community-based voluntary health organization dedicated to eliminating cancer as a major health problem by preventing cancer, saving lives and diminishing suffering from cancer, through research, education advocacy and patient support services.

WHEREAS, Relay For Life is the American Cancer Society's signature activity to raise awareness and funds for the fight against cancer.


