

**RESOLUTION 13-51**

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE PURCHASING POLICY FOR THE CITY OF  
SPRING HILL**

**WHEREAS**, as required by the Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983, Sections 6-5-301 through 6-56-307, Tennessee Code Annotated, the City of Spring Hill, by Resolution 08-65, adopted a comprehensive written purchasing policy on December 15, 2008; and


**WHEREAS**, the existing Purchasing Policy for the City of Spring Hill, Section XX (i) requires disposal by auction for equipment valued greater than \$100.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill desires to amend the Purchasing Policy for the City of Spring Hill, Section XX (i) (Sale of Surplus Property) as follows:


**“(i) Sale of Surplus Property**

*“When the Purchasing Agent decides there is surplus equipment or material in the city, he shall figure out the best way to dispose of those items with an estimated value of less than \$1,000.00 and dispose of them with a report to the governing board. Items with an estimated value of more than \$1,000.00 shall be advertised for bidding or be sold at public auction, which will begin after the purchasing agent has received approval from the governing body. Such equipment or materials will be sold to the highest bidder.*


