**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF NEW VEHICLES FOR
THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Department is in need of new vehicles; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill included thirteen new vehicles in the budget for fiscal year 2013-2014.

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill wishes to save the cost of advertising for proposals and accept the statewide bid contract amount for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has reviewed prior proposals and has made a recommendation to the Budget Finance Advisory Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of 13 new vehicles from GM of Murfreesboro for a total cost of \$289,028.54; consisting of nine patrol vehicles at \$21,225.14 each, totaling \$191,026.26; two detective vehicles at \$21,225.14, totaling \$42,450.28; and two administrative vehicles at \$27,776.00 each totaling \$55,552.00; as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on July 8, 2013.
