

RESOLUTION 14-30

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE UPSIZING OF A WATER MAIN
ON COMMONWEALTH DRIVE**

WHEREAS, the City's water system is in need of a second 18 inch water main feed to the proposed Hardin's Landing Water Tank; and

WHEREAS, Commonwealth Drive is getting ready to begin construction and the construction plan currently shows construction of a water main; and


WHEREAS, Title 18, Section 145 of the City of Spring Hill Municipal Code authorizes credits to be extended against the payment of water and sewer fees in exchange for upsizing water and sewer lines; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a cost estimate for the upsizing in the amount of \$95,604.00, and this amount of money is equivalent to the tap fees collected for approximately 65 single-family residential units; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Alderman for the City of Spring Hill authorizes a credit, not to exceed \$95,604.00, to be given to John Maher Builders for upsizing from an 8" to an 18" water main on Commonwealth Drive, and that said credit may be applied to any single family residential permits within the limits of the City of Spring Hill.


The aforementioned credit shall not become available until the 18" water line has been installed, constructed, and accepted in accordance with the standards and regulations of the City of Spring Hill. The credit as described above shall expire one year from date of adoption of this resolution.
