**WHERE AS**, many descendants of those who created the history of Spring Hill continue to inhabit our City; and


**WHERE AS**, Spring Hill is statistically one of the fastest growing cities in Tennessee, and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Government agrees to promote and assist in the conduct of the Annual Spring Hill Founders Day.

Passed and adopted this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2014.




