WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Department transitioned to the Glock .40 caliber handgun as its primary duty issued handgun in 2004; and


WHEREAS, due to the age and use of these weapons, Spring Hill Police Department is replacing the current Glock handguns with Smith and Wesson 9 mm as its departmental issued service weapon; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Department put out a RFP for Smith and Wesson 9 mm handguns to licensed Federal Firearms Dealers; and

WHEREAS, Spring Hill Police Department will dispose of current Glock handguns as a trade-in- allowance towards the purchase price of Smith and Wesson handguns; and


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of Smith and Wesson handguns from King's Firearms and More, LLC , and to dispose of current departmental Glock handguns as a trade-in allowance of \$15,400.00, for a total cost of \$12,063.40, as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on September 15, 2014.



OVERVIEW:

- Spring Hill Police Department purchased Glock .40 caliber handguns in 2004 to be carried by officers as their primary duty issued handgun. The handgun is a tool, and after years of use, the weapons, like tools, start to have issues as far as parts wearing out and or breaking. Firearms staff reviewed these weapons, and made the recommendation to replace them. After testing different makes and models of firearms on our range, the Smith and Wesson 9mm handgun was chosen as the weapon to be carried as our primary duty issued handgun.
- Departments across the country carry different make, model and caliber handguns. Each department chooses what is best for them based on various factors. Just like opinions on what vehicle one would buy, Chevrolet, Ford, Dodge, weapons are no different.
- The 9 mm ammunition cost less than the .40 caliber and is more readily available. The 9mm handgun has less recoil when firing. This is important to training in that the officers shooting confidence will rise and their shots on target is better, with the ultimate goal of all shots fired hit the target. We are accountable for every round we fire, during training misses or shots off target results in points deducted on the officers score. This translates into the day to day operations of an officer in that should they have to fire their weapon in the line of duty, all shots fired will strike the intended target in order to stop the threat. Any round that does not hit the intended target, could or may result in injury to a bystander.
- Stopping power is often discussed when choosing a weapon and many people believe that the larger the bullet, ie. .45 caliber, translates to greater stopping power. Stopping power can be looked at as the type of ammunitions effectiveness to render a person unable to offer resistance or remain a threat to the officer, victim or other. The ammunitions penetration and expansion play a vital role, but the ultimate stopping power rests in the training with our weapon. Shot placement, ie., hitting the intended target in

center mass to stop the threat is a key element. New ballistics for the 9mm round causes the round to expand on impact, thus reducing the chance for the round to pass through the body.

- The Smith and Wesson 9mm design and function factored into the final decision as to our choice of weapon. It is reliable and has performed well under testing. The weapon is ergonomically designed and up to date with modern weapons. It forms to the hands of the shooter because of various interchangeable grips. Grip or holding the weapon is one of the elements of shooting. The grip design puts the shooters hand in a natural firing position, therefore helping manage recoil, which allows the officer to acquire the target better. There is a round indicator for chambered round. Magazines are interchangeable for left or right handed shooters and are metal, therefore offering a longer lifespan. The rail system allows for different sources of light, giving different choices rather than only one option of a mounted light. Two extra rounds of ammo carried compared to present .40 caliber magazine.
- Part of the RFP stipulated that our present duty issued handgun, Glock, will be traded-in for an allowance towards the purchasing price of the Smith and Wessons. Also, our present .40 caliber ammunition that we have in stock will be traded in for exchange to the 9 mm ammunition.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- RFP was submitted for publication to licensed Federal Firearms Dealers. Kings Firearms and More, LLC., Columbia, was the only bid received.

Change of Address (27 CFR 478.52). Licensees may during the term of their current license remove their business or activity to a new location at which they intend regularly to carry on such business or activity by filing an Application for an Amended Federal Firearms License, ATF Form 5300.38, in duplicate, not less than 30 days prior to such removal with the Chief, Federal Firearms Licensing Center. The application must be executed under the penalties of perjury and penalties imposed by 18 U.S.C. 924. The application shall be accompanied by the licensee's original license. The license will be valid for the remainder of the term of the original license. (The Chief, FFLC, shall, if the applicant is not qualified, refer the application for amended license to the Director of Industry Operations for denial in accordance with § 478.71.)
