A RESOLUTION TO PETITION THE TENNESSEE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION TO DENY ANY REQUEST FOR ALCOHOL SALES AT THE MOVIE THEATER UNDER CONSTRUCTION LOCATED AT 2068 CROSSINGS CIRCLE, SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen is committed to the safety and well-being of the community; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is unique in that its median age is lower than most cities of its size as Spring Hill is home to many young families; and

WHEREAS, there has recently been a request for an on-premise beer permit at the movie theater by Eastwynn Theaters, Inc., a subsidiary of Carmike Theaters, which was ultimately withdrawn by Eastwynn; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen feels that the sale of alcohol at a movie theater is also inappropriate for a family establishment for the same reasons, due to the negative impact on the health, safety and welfare said permitting would have on the community of Spring Hill.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby respectfully petition the Tennessee Alcohol Beverage Commission to deny any future request for a liquor by the drink and/or on-premises consumption and/or wine only license at the movie theater at 2068 Crossings Circle, Spring Hill, Tennessee.
