WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT**


WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant is in need of a polymer system; and

WHEREAS, Staff has submitted a recommendation to the Budget Finance Advisory Committee;



STAFF MEMORANDUM

We received three bids one of which was the low bid of \$11,500 which doesn't qualify because installation wasn't included in the bid. Staff is recommending that we go with UGSI Chemical Feed, INC which bid \$15,869 and meets all specs that were specified. I talked with Jerome Dempsey and he agrees with this decision. The third bid was \$38,000.

We budgeted \$25,000 for this project and came in under budget at \$15,869.


