WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill desires to complete the project for which it has received grant funding from TDOT; and



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 17th day of August, 2015.





Dempsey, Dilling & Associates, P.C. (DDA) has reviewed the bid submitted by DMC, Inc. for the Tanyard Springs Trail Project which is being administered through TDOT with funds from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The contract is for an elevated wooden pedestrian trail to be constructed near Williford Court north to Spring Hill City Limits and connect to Thompson's Station's Safe Route to School Project which has already been constructed.

DMC, Inc. was the only bidder with a total bid price of \$97,227.69. A copy of the Bid Tabulation is attached for your reference as well. DMC, Inc. and all of their sub-contractors will be required to maintain a current TDOT Prequalified Contractor status during the course of the project. Based on the review of the provided information and previous experience, it has been determined that DMC, Inc. is a responsible party capable of completing the work required in the contract.

A concurrence package will be submitted to TDOT as soon as all of the newspaper affidavits are received. Pending TDOT's concurrence, it is DDA's recommendation that the City of Spring Hill accepts the proposal from DMC, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible party and award the contract in the amount of \$97,227.69 for the proposed project.
