WHEREAS, The City of Spring Hill is required to provide certain services to the citizens of Spring Hill; and


WHEREAS, in order to provide mowing related services, the Public Works Department requires quality equipment to perform such functions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved the purchase of a new tractor on March 16, 2015 in the amount of \$22,850.00; and

WHEREAS, there is an opportunity to trade in and upgrade to a larger tractor with a price of \$31,400.00; with a trade in allowance of \$23,000.00.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 21st day of September, 2015.





OVERVIEW: We purchased a new tractor and have the opportunity to trade it in for larger tractor (4608) that can do the necessary work.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- For future use, the existing tractor motor will not last; therefore it would be feasible to take the opportunity to upsize, while the supplier is offering this trade-in arrangement.

PROJECT/CONTRACT UPDATES:

- Original tractor was purchased in April 2015 for \$22,850.00 from Clebourne Farm Supply.

The allowance for the tractor is \$23,000.00; the price of the larger tractor is \$31,400.00.

The cost to the city is \$8,400.00.
