

**RESOLUTION 15-128**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF (2) NEW POLICE VEHICLES AND ANCILLARY EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department was allocated funding to purchase new police vehicles with ancillary equipment in the current 2015-2016 fiscal year budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department is requesting the purchase of two Chevrolet Traverses on state contract from GMC of Murfreesboro and ancillary equipment from On Duty Depot; and

**WHEREAS**, the total state contract cost of the two vehicles are \$52,000.00 and the total cost of ancillary equipment from On Duty Depot is \$5,724.00; and


**WHEREAS**; City staff has reviewed prior proposals and has made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of two (2) Chevrolet Traverses for a total of \$52,000.00 from GMC of Murfreesboro and ancillary equipment from On Duty Depot for \$5,724.00 at a grand total cost of \$57,724.00, as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on December 7, 2015.



**OVERVIEW:** The Police Department was allocated \$405,000.00 to purchase new vehicles in the current budget year. (7) Chevrolet Caprices with equipment were already authorized and I am requesting to purchase (2) Chevrolet Traverse's with equipment for our detectives division.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This request is to replace a 2006 Chevrolet Impala and a 2006 Chrysler 300 presently being driven by detectives. By replacing these vehicles, the detective's division will be outfitted with newer vehicles and will not need replacement vehicles in the near future. The Traverse is a midsize SUV, with the Equinox and Tahoe being the other SUV's that GM offers. A SUV is more suitable for detectives in their scope of work. The purchase of the Traverses will be from GMC of Murfreesboro off of State Contract. The equipment will be from On Duty Depot from quotes.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** If approved, the total cost of the two (2) traverses is \$52,000.00 and the total cost of the equipment is \$5,724.00. This will leave a balance of \$26,542.35 for vehicles in this current budget.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Based on pricing of Traverse's from State Contract, staff recommends purchasing two (2) Chevrolet Traverse's from GMC of Murfreesboro and equipment off of quotes from other vendors for a total cost of \$57,724.00.
