**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE CONDITIONS OF UTILITY CUT ON
PORT ROYAL ROAD**


WHEREAS, it is generally a policy of the City of Spring Hill to not allow open cuts for utilities across finished roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen wishes to review each open cut request individually; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the extenuating circumstances in this request of Old South Properties to connect utilities from the east side of Port Royal Road to the west side of Port Royal Road are mitigated by the significant milling and overlay of the whole roadway width as a part of the turn lane requirements and is therefore approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby directs staff to work with the developer so that the time between the roadway cut and milling and overlay is minimized and be no more than 30 days.


