WHEREAS, we feel thus type of facility is needed:


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town of Spring Hill:

That a workable plan be instituted for continuation of this project in the next fiscal year with adequate funds provided in that year's budget, and:


That a copy of this resolution be presented to the County Court of Maury County prior to their next regular meeting.
