

R E S O L U T I O N NO. 77-1

WHEREAS, The road leading in a northwesterly direction from the center of the Town of Spring Hill toward the former L. & N. Railroad station has been designated as Depot Road or Depot Street for many years; and

WHEREAS, The depot has not been in use for some-time and the building has been demolished and no longer exists: and

WHEREAS, The right of way for the railroad was given by former owners of the historic and adjacent Ewell Farm: and


WHEREAS Ewell Farm and its owners over the years have contributed much to the well being and reputation of Spring Hill:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town of Spring Hill:

That the name of this road or street be changed from Depot Road or Depot Street, and shall henceforth be known as Ewell Road in honor of the role which this historic landmark has played in the life of the Spring Hill community, and:

Further, that a short street running in a southeasterly direction from Main to School Street, which, up to this time, has not been named, be henceforth known as Ferguson Street, in honor of the historic mansion adjacent thereto and located on the property of the Tennessee Orphan Home.
