

RESOLUTION 25-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, OPPOSING TENNESSEE HOUSE BILL 0895

WHEREAS, the Duck River is a vital resource for Spring Hill, providing water for drinking, recreation, agriculture, and supporting local ecosystems; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of Tennessee issued an Executive Order protecting the Duck Rivers water quality; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee House Bill 0895 threatens to weaken protections for the Duck River by relaxing water quality standards, conflicting with the Governors Executive Order and undermining efforts to preserve and protect the river; and

WHEREAS, Spring Hill is committed to environmental stewardship and maintaining the health of the Duck River for future generations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Spring Hill opposes Tennessee House Bill 0895 and urges the Tennessee General Assembly to reject this bill due to its direct conflict with the Governors Executive Order and its potential harm to the Duck Rivers water quality.




