

RESOLUTION 25-90

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEDICATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL
AT THE INTERSECTION OF BATTLE CREEK WAY AND MAHLON MOORE
ROAD IN MAURY COUNTY, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is committed to the safety and well-being of its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Battle Creek Way and Mahlon Moore Road is a critical point of access for numerous residents, commuters, and local businesses; and

WHEREAS, the increased traffic volume in the area, particularly during peak hours, has raised concerns about the safety and efficiency of traffic flow at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, there have been reports of frequent traffic congestion, as well as an increased risk of accidents at this location; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the importance of ensuring safe and smooth traffic movement to enhance overall public safety; and

WHEREAS, the upgrade of a traffic light at this intersection would significantly improve traffic control, reduce the risk of accidents, and facilitate safer driving conditions for all individuals utilizing this roadway; and

WHEREAS, Spring Hill has previously engaged with Maury County and other local stakeholders regarding the need for improvements to this intersection to address traffic concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill authorizes the following action:

1. To authorize staff to forward this resolution and request dedication of the traffic signal at the intersection of Battle Creek Way and Mahlon Moore Road.
2. To authorize staff to prepare a cost estimate to upgrade the signal and prepare necessary appropriations within the budget for the Board of Mayor and Alderman to approve.
