**WHEREAS**, Mayor Hagaman sustained commitment to public service spans four years, reflecting a deep and enduring dedication to the community's well-being; and


**WHEREAS**, throughout his tenure, Jim Hagaman has consistently worked to advance the interests of the city's residents and contribute to its ongoing progress and development; and

2. That this resolution shall stand as a permanent tribute to Mayor Hagaman's significant contributions to the community.


