FOR THE UTILITY DEPARTMENT**





**PURPOSE:**

To approve Resolution 25-125 to approve sale of surplus Utility Vehicles and Golf Carts that have exceeded their useful life.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City of Spring Hill Utility Department has two vehicles that have surpassed their useful life. Historically, the Utility Department utilizes vehicles as long as possible. Currently, both vehicles have exceeded their anticipated life expectancy and are ineffective in transporting staff safely and effectively in completing their daily duties. The two golf carts were purchased to be used on the wastewater treatment plant grounds. These golf carts are currently inoperable with the projected cost to repair exceeding the life expectancy and value of the items.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

Proceeds from the sale of these items will be issued to the water/ sewer fund.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 25-125 to approve sale of vehicles and golf carts.
