

**RESOLUTION 25-150**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, through its Board of Mayor and Aldermen, has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to pursue contract negotiations for the vacant City Administrator position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen have identified J. Carter Napier as a qualified individual to provide said services; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and appropriate for the City Attorney to be authorized to commence formal contract negotiations on behalf of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that:

**Section 1.** The City Attorney is hereby directed and authorized to enter into contract negotiations with J. Carter Napier for the vacant City Administrator position.

**Section 2.** The City Attorney shall ensure that all contract negotiations comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws.


**Section 3.** The City Attorney is authorized to take all necessary and appropriate actions to facilitate such negotiations, including the preparation and review of all relevant documentation.


