Section 1. The City recognizes the dedication, sportsmanship and excellent performance of these student-athletes, who have brought honor and pride to their school and community.


Section 2. The City extends its congratulations to the players, coaches, support staff, families and all who contributed to this remarkable season and historic accomplishment.
