**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE WRAP AROUND CLOSET AND DESIGNATING NOVEMBER AS ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the importance of supporting children and families in foster care and undergoing adoption, and the vital role local organizations play in meeting their needs; and

**WHEREAS**, The Wrap Around Closet, a community-based nonprofit organization, serves between 60 and 100 children each month by providing tangible necessities such as clothing, equipment, and toiletries to children in foster care and families in crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, The Wrap Around Closet has been instrumental in initiating and growing community outreach programs including the annual *Fostering Hope* Christmas event and *Back to School Carnival*, which provide children with school supplies, new shoes, and joyful experiences; and

**WHEREAS**, in the summer of 2025, the *Back to School Carnival* served 420 children with essential supplies and a fun, supportive event, while the *Fostering Hope* Christmas program anticipates serving close to 1,000 children this December with meaningful holiday gifts; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill desires to recognize and commend The Wrap Around Closet and all who support foster and adoptive families in our community for their ongoing compassion, service, and commitment to making a difference in the lives of children; and

**WHEREAS**, the month of November is nationally recognized as *Adoption Awareness Month*, providing an opportunity to raise awareness, show gratitude to foster and adoptive parents and caregivers, and encourage continued community involvement and support.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that:**

1. The Board hereby recognizes and expresses its sincere appreciation to *The Wrap Around Closet* for its outstanding service to children and families in need throughout the Spring Hill community.
2. The month of November is hereby recognized as Adoption Awareness Month in the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.
