

RESOLUTION 25-301

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF WATER, WASTEWATER, AND STORMWATER CAPITAL PROJECTS TO THE TENNESSEE STATE REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill maintains a multi-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) that identifies critical water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure projects necessary to ensure reliable service, regulatory compliance, environmental stewardship, and continued support for community growth; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) administers the State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF) programs for drinking water, clean water (wastewater), and stormwater, which provide low-interest financing for eligible public utility infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is eligible to apply for and receive SRF funding for projects listed in its adopted Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, participation in the SRF program requires governing body authorization for staff to prepare and submit applications for funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, authorizing staff to submit SRF applications does not obligate the City to accept any loan award, nor does it commit the City to any financing until such time that a loan agreement is formally approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen:

Section 1. Authorization to Submit Projects.

City staff are hereby authorized to prepare and submit applications to the Tennessee State Revolving Loan Fund programs for any water, wastewater, and stormwater projects identified in the City's adopted Capital Improvement Program.

Section 2. Authority to Provide Required Documentation.

City staff are further authorized to provide all supporting documentation, engineering reports, environmental reviews, financial information, resolutions of authorization, and any other materials required by TDEC for SRF application completeness.

Section 3. No Financial Obligation Created.

Approval of this Resolution shall not obligate the City to accept any loan award or enter into any loan agreement. Any SRF loan offered to the City shall require separate consideration and approval by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.
