

ORDINANCE NO. 73-5

AREA V

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY AND TO INCORPORATE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, a public hearing before this body was held on the 8th. day of March, 1973, pursuant to Resolution No. 73-2 adopted on February 26, 1973, and notice thereof published in the Columbia Daily Herald on February 28, 1973; and,

WHEREAS, it now appears that the prosperity of this town and of the territory herein described will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property thereof endangered if such territory is not annexed; and,

WHEREAS, the annexation of such territory is deemed necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners thereof and of this town as a whole; and,

WHEREAS, a plan of service for this area was adopted by Resolution No. 73-1 on February 26, 1973, as required by section 6-309, Tennessee Code Annotated;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee:

Section 1. Pursuant to authority conferred by sections 6-308 to 6-320, Tennessee Code Annotated, there is hereby annexed to the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, and incorporated within the corporate boundaries thereof, the following described territory adjoining the present corporate boundaries:

Embracing that certain part of the Third Civil District of Maury County, Tennessee, and more fully described, to-wit:

Beginning at that point which is the most southerly in the existing city limits line (the same being the point of intersection of the southerly property line of the Tennessee Orphan Home with the westerly right-of-way line of the old Kedron Pike); thence southerly a distance of approximately 450 feet along the westerly right-of-way line of the old Kedron Pike to that point where this westerly right-of-way line intersects the center line of McCutcheon Creek; thence following the center line of McCutcheon Creek westerly a distance of approximately 25 feet to the point of intersection of the center line of McCutcheon Creek with the center line of an unnamed westerly branch of McCutcheon Creek; thence westerly with the center line of the unnamed westerly branch of McCutcheon Creek a distance of approximately 4500 feet to a point which is 300 feet east of the nearest point in the easterly right-of-way of U. S. Highway 31; thence northerly to the point of intersection with the existing city limits line (the "high water line on the north bank" of this unnamed westerly branch); thence clockwise with the existing city limits to the point of beginning and containing some 102 acres. This area would be located in the 1st. Ward of the town.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
