RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR SERVICES RENDERED TO RESTORE HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE MODULES


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee experienced a devastating cyber ransom-ware attack on November 3rd, and is in the process of incurring certain capital and service related expenditures to be made with respect to restoring data bases with Tyler Technologies, Inc. (Tyler); and

WHEREAS, Tyler has been retained to provide assistance in the recovery process for various hardware/software modules the City uses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee is currently beginning to receive invoices from Tyler that need to be processed for payment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, authorizes payments to Tyler, which may include some invoices over \$10,000, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00.


