**A RESOLUTION TO RELEASE THE PERFORMANCE BOND FOR
WAL-MART TURN LANE INSTALLATION**

WHEREAS, a Performance Bond for Wal-Mart in the amount of \$65,000.00 is currently in place for the installation of a north bound right turn at the intersection of Main Street and Campbell Station Parkway; and


WHEREAS, the City has obtained the required right-of-way for said installation per the terms of the bond; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of installing the turn lane, the City has negotiated with Wal-Mart to install the turn lane at full expense to the City in exchange for payment of the bond amount; and

WHEREAS, the City will release the existing Performance Bond upon receipt of certified funds.





RESOLUTION 17-45

**A RESOLUTION TO SELECT CONTRACTOR FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
THE JOHN LUNN ROAD BRIDGE REPAIRS**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorized the City to enter into a bridge grant program with TDOT to repair the bridge on John Lunn Road that is structurally deficient by Resolution 16-122; and


WHEREAS, the City advertised for the construction of the John Lunn Road bridge repairs and bids were opened on April 11, 2017; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the selection of Jenkins & Jenkins, Inc. be awarded the contract with a low bid of \$384,237.08; and

WHEREAS, Collier Engineering Co., Inc. will provide the engineering services for the project at 15% of total cost (not to exceed \$58,000.00) as noted in Resolution 16-122.




