
**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE DONATION
OF A 10.75-ACRE TRACT TO THE CITY OF SPRING HILL
FROM REVERE AT SPRING HILL, LLC**

WHEREAS, the public good demands the City's acceptance of the subject property upon the donation from Revere to the City.




