FOR THE WIDENING OF DUPLEX ROAD PROJECT**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill is currently engaged with TDOT to widen Duplex Road; and

## **STAFF MEMORANDUM**

Once the construction phase of the widening of Duplex Road commences, TDOT will be responsible for the actual construction. However, the City is responsible for the construction engineering and inspection services for the utility relocation during construction.

- City staff recommends utilizing Dempsey, Dilling and Associates for these services. DDA designed and engineered all the utility relocation plans as contracted by the City.
- City staff has verified with TDOT that we can use the same company for design and CEI services.
- DDA is CEI certified and is on the approved list from TDOT.
- City staff has confirmed with DDA that they have the adequate staff available to perform these services.
- Estimated CEI cost would be \$350,000 based on a total relocation cost of \$5,716,051.

## **STAFF MEMORANDUM**
