

**RESOLUTION 18-98**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF INVOICE FROM GNRC  
FOR THE SOUTH CORRIDOR TRANSIT STUDY**

**WHEREAS**, Tennessee's Long-Range Transportation Policy Plan recognizes the benefit of interregional highway corridors in providing citizens and businesses throughout Tennessee with high quality access to educational, employment, health care and recreational opportunities that also supports commerce and tourism; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the importance of transit as a transportation system improvement serving communities, residents and businesses located along the Interstate 65 Corridor south of Metropolitan Davidson County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved participation and funding in the Tennessee Department of Transportation agreement between Williamson County, Maury County, the City of Franklin, the Town of Thompson's Station, the City of Spring Hill, the City of Columbia, the Nashville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (e.g., Greater Nashville Regional Council) and the Tennessee Department of Transportation to conduct a South Corridor Transit Study; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of the South Corridor Transit Study project has expanded resulting in the need for additional funding from each participant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill had initially budgeted \$10,000 for its contribution to the South Corridor Transit Study; and


**WHEREAS**, based upon the increase scope and related fee the Greater Nashville Regional Council has issued an invoice to the City of Spring Hill in the amount of \$16,667 representing an increase in project expense to the City of Spring Hill of \$6,667.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the payment of the attached invoice (#18-SC-04) from Greater Nashville Regional Council (GNRC) in the amount of \$16,667.00 for the updated local share of the South Corridor Transit Study the funding source of which shall be from Adequate Facilities Tax fund.



Dear Mayor Graham,

Please find attached an **invoice for your local share of the costs related to the upcoming South Corridor Transit Study**. The study, which is budgeted in the MPO's adopted Unified Planning Work Program, is being conducted as a follow-up to the Nashville MTA/ RTA nMotion recommendations.

The GNRC has hired a consultant team led by WSP USA to evaluate the feasibility of a range of local and regional transit options and to develop strategies to link economic development, urban design, and land use to the recommended transit investments. The study will include extensive public and stakeholder outreach, ridership projections, and financial modeling for various large-scale transit alternatives.

The effort is being funded through a partnership among the Nashville Area MPO, RTA, TDOT, and local government members along the I-65/ US 31 corridor from Nashville into Maury County.
