**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE
CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE TO APPLY FOR AND
PARTICIPATE IN BETTER UTILIZING INVESTMENTS TO LEVERAGE
DEVELOPMENT (BUILD) TRANSPORTATION GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill understands Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Transportation Grant funds are available for application by the City as an investment in surface transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill seeks and supports an application to the United States Department of Transportation for BUILD grant funds to assist in the development of the Buckner Road Interchange located within the City of Spring Hill along Interstate 65; and


WHEREAS, the Buckner Road Interchange will provide a regional transportation solution with vital transportation access connecting Interstate 65 to U.S. 31/State Route 6 and U.S. 431/State Route 106 serving Williamson County, Maury County, Town of Thompsons Station and the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the Interchange would facilitate and encourage further regional economic benefits, as well as improvements to the quality of life, not only for the City of Spring Hill, but the Town of Thompsons Station and Williamson and Maury County, Tennessee and other surrounding rural and developing areas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL,
TENNESSEE, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN THAT:**


- 1) The City of Spring Hill, Tennessee strongly supports the BUILD grant application for the Buckner Road Interchange.
- 2) The Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill will authorize the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the grant awarded for the project in an amount up to Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000) in local matching funds for the grant.
- 3) The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the BUILD application and any follow up documentation required or requested by the United States Department of Transportation related to this application and project.
- 4) The Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee supports the grant application and pledges its full support and hereby authorizes and directs full cooperation with the appropriate national, state and local authorities to implement this application and any necessary supporting documentation.


