RE: Grease control

Fats, oils, and greases from Food Service facilities can have a negative impact on the City's wastewater collection and treatment system.

Rather than simply reacting to grease related sewer blockages, Spring Hill's sewer department is making proactive facility inspections and is convinced that the effort will result in cost savings and environmental benefits.

Due to the importance of this matter, the City's sewer department will assist you in developing a Grease Control program.

Attached you will find a copy of Spring Hill's Fats, Oils, and, Grease (FOG) ordinance. Also you will find a brief facility survey for you to fill out and return.

After review of the survey, we will make a routine inspection of your facility. As inspections are made, we will advise you of any deficiencies, repairs, or additions needed to comply with the City ordinance.

Your co-operation and promptness in this matter is greatly appreciated.
