**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO SEND A LETTER TO
THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TDOT)
REQUESTING FUNDING FROM TDOT'S LOCAL INTERSTATE
CONNECTOR PROGRAM (LIC)**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee applied for and was awarded the BUILD Grant going toward the construction of a new Buckner Road Interchange with I-65; and


WHEREAS, this project contains multiple segments: the interchange, the two new interchange connector roads and the widening of the existing Buckner Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill requests funding from TDOT's Local Interstate Connector (LIC) Program for each of the two new connector segments and also for Buckner Road widening when its right-of-way phase begins.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, authorizes the Mayor to send the attached letter requesting Tennessee Department of Transportation Local Interstate Connector funding for the BUILD Grant project for the City of Spring Hill.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill requests that the Tennessee Department of Transportation be responsible for the interchange portion of the project, including the remaining expense above its 25 million BUILD Grant funds.

Dear Paul,

As you are aware, the City of Spring Hill has applied for and received a BUILD Grant of \$25,000,000.00 going toward the construction of a new Buckner Road interchange with I-65. The entire project contains four segments. The interchange itself, two new interchange connector roads and the widening of the existing Buckner Road.

The City of Spring Hill requests funding from TDOT's Local Interstate Connector (LIC) program for each of the two new connector segments and also for Buckner Road widening when its right-of-way phase begins. We understand there is a \$2,000,000.00 cap per segment. The city will be responsible for the remaining costs of these segments.

The City of Spring Hill will have significant investment in these connecting segments that are not part of the state highway system. If the City of Spring Hill utilizes the entire grant funds toward the interchange itself, it is requested that TDOT cover the remaining balance with state funds.

Please let us know if this is acceptable and what steps we need to take in order to proceed.
