
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AMENDING
SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1 MISCELLANEOUS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen have previously created rules and regulations related to operating motor vehicles, traffic and parking within the Spring Hill City Limits; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to amend said regulations to regulate construction traffic and associate vehicles within the Spring Hill City Limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that Title 15, Chapter 1 Miscellaneous of the Spring Hill Municipal Code be amended as provided in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Chapter 1: Miscellaneous

To be added:

15-126 CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC

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Construction traffic and ancillary vehicles must utilize any and all designated construction entrances and routes when so established by the Planning Commission during the entitlement process or the City Infrastructure Director or City Engineer and/or their designee any time thereafter. In no case shall the City require the acquisition of additional property to serve as construction entrance.
