

Ordinance No. 21-19 A

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 16-14 (AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A PRIVILEGE TAX UPON THE OCCUPANCY IN ANY HOTEL OR MOTEL OR ANY PLACE IN WHICH ROOMS, LODGING, OR ACCOMMODATIONS ARE FURNISHED TO TRANSIENTS FOR CONSIDERATION).

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 496 amending Tenn. Code Ann. §67-4-1402 authorizes the City of Spring Hill to adjust the hotel occupancy tax to 4%.

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill deems it to be in the best interest of the City to levy the hotel tax under the new Public Chapter 496

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Public Chapter 496 requires a municipality with an authorized tax upon the privilege of occupancy on or before July 1, 2021 shall not adopt a tax under Public Chapter 496 unless the municipality repeals the preexisting authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. Repeal of Ordinance 16-14. Ordinance 16-14 is hereby repealed in full.

Section 2. Date of Effect. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption by two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) vote of the Board and Mayor and Alderman at two (2) consecutive regularly scheduled meetings but not before January 1, 2022, the public welfare requiring it.


